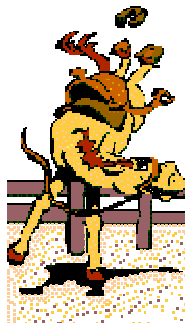

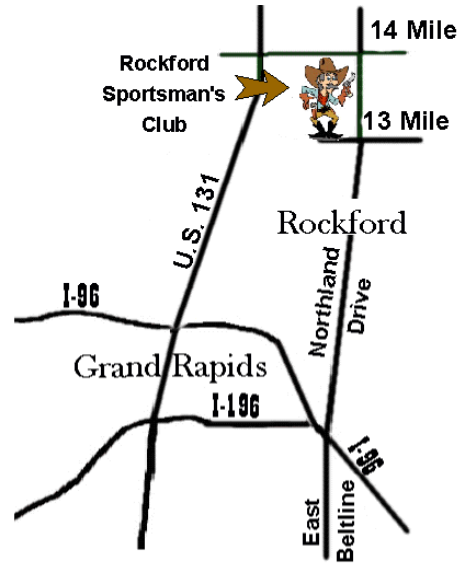

Come on out to the Rockford Sportsman's Club the first Saturday of each month (except November) and join in on the fun.

New shooters are welcome cause we like showing the greenhorns how it's done. We really do like spectators - gives us more incentive to show-off (remember to bring ear and eye protection).

Sign-up begins at 8:30 a.m. with the mandatory safety meeting at 9:30 a.m. Shooting commences thereafter.

Registration is \$17 per shooter, which includes a free lunch. A \$2 discount for all badge wearing Wolverine Rangers, RSC members or Ladies (only one discount applies). Junior shooter fee is only \$10.

Wearin' the clothes suitable to the period is almost as much fun as shootin' the old west guns. At least some effort must be made to dress the part of your "persona". No baseball caps, tennis shoes, nylon, Velcro, short sleeved shirts, designer jeans or ad campaigns.



Hardware Requirements

2 Single Action Pistols
of centerfire .32 caliber or larger.
Holsters required.

Lever or Pump Action Rifle
with exposed hammer, tube magazine.
Centerfire pistol caliber only.

Shotgun choices
"Double Barrel" without auto ejector.
"Pump and Lever Action" must have
exposed hammers. 10 to 20 gauge.



Ammunition Requirements

Pistol: 50 plus rounds less than 1000fps

Rifle: 50 plus rounds less than 1400fps

Shotgun: 25 plus rounds of low brass target
ammo only. No larger than #6 shot.

No Magnums or field loads.

Lead bullets only - no gas checks,
jacketed or copper washed.

The bringing of extra ammo is highly
recommended.



Eye and Ear Protection
