Recent Emails from RSC members who expressed their opinions on this were passed out to all present This led to lengthy discussion to which the power point for archery project was given.
- **Archery presentation:** Josh Zuiderveen, Todd Billin, & Arn McIntyre... Emails that were circulated had extensive questions and comments that need to be addressed. A power point presentation was given to clarify answers, and or untruths of the archery pending project. The power point was informative and addressing the following: impact on RSC, keeping the club private security, safety & liability, public use, club usage, benefit to the RSC members, the investment of RSC with Algoma township to the community, funding , land and building ownership. Handouts were given along with a tri-fold directly from the power point to all those present. Question and answers followed. Twp Supervisor Denny Hoemke answered some direct questions concerning the twp involvement and responsibility. Bill Skallos made a motion to the Board - The Board of directors of the RSC authorizes the Archery Committee to proceed with grant and funding procurement, and to negotiate a public and land use agreement with Algoma Twp. to allow public use of the facility. They will present the agreement to the Board for approval and signature. The Board also authorizes the Archery committee to supervise design and construction of the archery building and outdoor range, using McIntyre Builders Inc as construction manager, Bill Skallos as Architect, and Streamworks LLC for grant procurement. Board members, George Mayhak, Barbara Blough, Marti Scrivener, Gordon Pickerd, Dan'l Dixon, Peter Kreutzfeldt, Mike Roche, Dave Devries, Shawn Blough voted in favor of this. Gordon supported the motion. Bill Skallos asked the Chairman if he should abstain from the vote, it was agreed upon .

- At this membership meeting the **Archery committee** did a power point presentation on the proposed archery facility. It was addressed by Jeff DeRegnaucourt that this continues to be transparent and that the archery group would meet with board members and RSC members on the second Tues. of the month, the third Tues of the month, the archery committee would present the board with the minutes to be updated. The next month's membership meeting would be presented with these minutes. The power point addressed the following: liability, open to the public, secured entrance, can the club remain private, can the club be secured if the archery facility is open, can the building be used for other things besides archery and air gun, can the outdoor range be used for other activities, benefits to RSC and it's members, staffing, LLC in question, bookkeeping and accounting, why is the township involved, and financial questions, and projected budget for the next 5yrs. It was then that the floor was open to questions; they were answered by Todd Billion, Jeff DeRegnaucourt, the township supervisor Dennis Hoemke, Arn McIntyre, Dave Scrivener, and Josh ZuiderVeen . Blue prints were available to view; these are not set in stone.
- The questions went as follows: Larry Postema: In a group meeting can anyone be present?
- Jim Devereaux : How much \$ can be brought in as a 501 C3 and not get in trouble with the IRS?
- Scott Fries: The \$60,000.00 from Gainsville....How profitable can this be?
- Jim Kovak: What access would a club member have to the facility?
- Miles Huffaker: What is the cost of this facility?
- Michael Green: In the plans you do not want to encroach on any existing shooting area correct?
- Dan'l Dixon: Is the Easton grant predicated to the DNR? What is your backup plan if you don't take the DNR \$\$\$
- Terry Stuart: What is our liability if the archery facility fails?
- Peter Kreutzfeldt: Can you guarantee me that the small group of archers will not encroach on any other shooting sport?
- Dan Vincent: We need to work together as a club, allowing each group to do their thing.
- Tony Gates: 1.) Arn, in your travels to other facility who paid for this? 2.) Will this change our property tax base from a 501 C3? 3.) Could we have just 1 day for club members? 4.) Will Easton, have any rights or sponsorship?
- Gary Rollenhagen: With this open to the public are they going to complain with the noise from the other shooting sports?
- Bill Skallos: Is it the townships intent to own the land and building?
- Denny Hoemke spoke and said that this WILL NOT be a Township Park so there will NOT be Township rules. The township is NOT interested in owning the building or land. You operate under yours and the DNRs' rules. We would be a facilitator of the money only.
- Patsy Green: Nice presentation. It is very transparent now; she does not want anything signed legally before the members have a chance to look at it.
- Geralynn Gardner: After 18 years, what happens if archery fails? What happens with the DNR in repayment? Do we sell the land for repayment?
- Tim Hall: yes or no answers 1.) Is it the intent of the archery group to be subservient to the Board and to the club? 2.) Is this a done deal?
- Ryan Wison: Why not use Algoma township land? You (Arn) will be the contractor and Bill the architect?
- At this point Terry Stuart said he came tonight to vote, yes to continue, or no
- Bill Harrison: Show me where it won't interfere with the 90 meter range.
- Glen Bradley makes a motion that the membership move forward and pursue building this building for archery. Jim Collins seconds the motion. Larry Postma: Is the Board going to have authority over the Archery Committee? Will the appointed Archery Committee let the Board see and approve the actual printed lease agreement before it's signed? At this point, Steve Durkee makes a suggestion to the original motion for it to say, "To allow the planning and review in continuing of the archery project until signing". The motion was second by Jim Jones. A vote was taken on the amendment For: 50 Against: 6. The second vote for the amended main motion was, "To carry on planning the project without signing any written agreement". For: 50, Against: 1. Gordon Pickerd gave a power point on the 4 stages of change.

Archery Project Committee planning meeting , main building.

We began by setting forth a series of time frames for planning purposes.

Once the legislature has approved the grant, the form will be sent to Algoma Township.  
0-30 days:

Recommend we have the club's law firm be involved for review of the grant agreement with the DNR and the Lease/use agreement in behalf of the club and to confirm the extent of the term mitigation.

Question: Josh indicated in a recent email that the DNR will allow reimbursement of some engineering costs prior to signing the agreement. Will the DNR prefund or allow for reimbursement out of the grant legal fees?

Question: Can we get a copy of the new sample DNR grant agreement form before the real document goes to the township?

Josh to meet with Denny at the township to establish a time frame and report back to the committee.

Arn McIntyre and Bill Skallos recommend we have the front and south property lines surveyed as this will be necessary in determining the orientation of the outdoor range and archery building. All discussed the probability of eliminating the need of the safe fall zone behind the 90 meter target butts if we have a high enough earth berm at the end of the range which would minimize the amount of hill and trees needed to be removed if we agree the north orientation is the way to go.

60 days from approval of grant by legislature:

Final site plan development/orientation.

Final review and approval of lease/land use agreement.

Meeting was called to order at 7:00pm. Gordon gave the invocation.

### Officer Reports

- **Vice President's Report: Barbara Blough.** Revised club brochure was handed out for review and updates. Updates will be given back and final draft will be distributed for review. Recommendation was made to have Kent ISD do the printing; this would reduce the printing costs. First three Articles of the club Bylaws were reviewed. Our 501c3 lawyer is also reviewing and will get back to RSC with any final recommendations. Gordon made motion to leave the first three articles the same, unless attorney states otherwise, supported by Bill, motion approved by all board members.
- **Treasurer's Report: Gordon Pickerd.** As of March 15<sup>th</sup>. Total Assets, \$88,593.31. Total Liabilities, \$8,399.50. Overall Total, \$80,193.81. Total Inflows, \$17,039.01. Total Outflows, \$16,059.98. Overall Total, \$979.03. Need to look into cleaning lead out of berms on pistol range. There is a Wetlands Workshop on March 28<sup>th</sup>.
- **Secretary's Report:** (given by Barbara Blough). Thank you received from Kent District Library on donation of \$200. Freeland Side by Side shoot information was given to Dan Vincent. Minutes from the February 22<sup>nd</sup> archery meeting were distributed.

### Trustee Reports

- Peter reported a Gun Show will be April 16 and 17. Also, the turning targets are damaged on the pistol range.
- Dan Dixon reported that range fees were being turned in. There was an issue with a rental, some cars were parked at the club overnight, and this was resolved. The table is still missing from the clubhouse. We will be looking into a timer for the vent in the kitchen to resolve the issue of it being left on after some rentals. Discussion regarding non-members up shooting without permission. Several resolutions were given, will determine best solution.
- Mike reported that the range rules are sent out with every new member information and to current members when they pay their annual dues. Mike made motion to accept new members Carolyn and Robert Stone, Amy and Kenneth Stone, Anissa and Aaron Wood, Kim and Len Laitila, Deborah and Karl Hassebrock, supported by Ryan, motion approved by all board members. Mike made motion to extend Jenny and Dan Frasco's membership for another year due to military service, supported by Gordon, motion approved by all board members.
- Ryan reported that there is an indoor IDPA on March 23<sup>rd</sup>. They are close to ordering steel targets.
- Dan Vincent found some more 22 shells on the skeet field, will discuss with George when he returns.
- Gordon reported that he and Dan Dixon talked to Denny Holmkee. When the land use and lease agreement are complete RSC needs to have people in place to review the language. The use agreement will say it is used for shooting sports activities, will not say archery specifically. DNR only coming back if building not being used for shooting sports and archery.
  - RSC needs attorney in place to work with Jim Brown from the township. Township does not want to run or control the building. Building ownership will be RSC to maintain and run. George called the MUCC attorney and the first 15 minutes are free then charged after. Dirk Roscamp, the 501c3 attorney would cost about \$2,500. Steve Hilger has dealt with municipalities and reviewed the DNR draft, Algoma not owner, tenant. Use and lease agreement are the most important documents to review when they are finished. Steve would negotiate his cost with a club membership. It was clarified that this would be an associate membership with no work requirements and no voting privileges. Gordon made motion to accept Steve Hilger due to his experience with municipalities, supported by Bill. Peter would rather have other attorney that would be paid, Dan Dixon would like to have other attorneys reviewed. Gordon question that if look at other attorneys would we be comfortable to do this selection via phone. Steve would email Gordon five top real estate lawyers; Gordon would review these with Dan Dixon. Bill stated that if lawyer is member it would be better for the club. Mike stated that no members are attorneys.

Seven board members approved of Gordon and Dan Dixon making phone calls, one board member was opposed.

- Some other questions that were asked are: How many pages would the lease agreement be and was there ever a situation where the DNR gave grant money and then required someone to pay it back. The lease agreement would be 20 to 30 pages. There were only two scenarios where the grant money was required to be paid back. One was where the money was given for a county park and several years later a county courthouse was built on the property. The other time was for a township to put up a building and it was later turned into a firehouse.
- The grant money has to be used for the intent that it was given, just like when RSC received a grant from the DNR to put in the parking lot by the clubhouse.
- Gordon withdrew motion made for Steve Hilger to be attorney.
