The skeet blitz for 13 dates during October increased our shooting income for the month and the drawing for free skeet lines each shoot day. Several times the lowest score of the day was drawn as the lucky winners. It was a fun event that allowed any score to prevail. The winter trap and skeet league will begin the first Sunday after New Year's Day with the same familiar format used in previous leagues. All levels of shooting skills are welcome as each shooter is in competition with individuals in his or her class.

It is finally here—the time to review the new budget for the 2014 year. This will be presented for comments and approval at the December meeting. Also at the December meeting the election of 2014 offices will be conducted. All regular members can cast their ballot, associate members can only vote when they have earned their regular membership status.

Please be reminded of the monthly auction for December. Even if your item did not sell at one meeting it may at the next with the rollover of members that attend each meeting.

Snow plowing was set up for the winter season and will be done any time two inches of snow accumulates. Last year several members completed their volunteer hours by keeping the walkways shoveled. Hopefully we can do the same this year.


