According to the updated Bylaws, May 2017, Retirees are now expected to support the club through volunteer hours and/or dues. BYLAWS

SECTION 2.1 Classifications of Membership

Retired Membership

A Retired membership will have maintained a Full membership of the Club for fifteen (15) years or more and the primary member have reached the age of 65 before the renewal date. The membership has all of the same privileges as a Full membership.

A Retired membership has no service hour or meeting requirement. Dues are assessed at 50% of the dues of a Full membership which has met the service hour requirement. Additionally, the dues may be offset by volunteering and earning service hour credits.

Based on current Membership dues requirements, \$180.00, a Retiree membership is responsible for annual dues of \$40.00 less \$5.00 per service hour. A Retiree that volunteers eight (8) or more hours will NOT be required to pay any dues.

NOTICE: ALL 100/200 YARD / ACTION RANGE SHOOTERS

One of the Long Range Plan projects the Club supported for 2017 was to provide electrical power to the Action range office and lighting of the 100/200 yard range shoot stand and targets. The Action range has been installed for several months now. Additionally, the Defensive pistol leadership's lighting request for their target storage shed has been installed.

The 100/200 yard range lighting is now fully functional. There was a component failure that delayed the 200 yard target lighting that has now been rectified.

All you shooters that are still working for a living can now come up to the Club after dinner to practice regardless of day, night or overcast weather.
