## May 17, 2022 RSC Board Meeting

**Guest Tim DeGeest** - Ram Nitro Team has been approached by Madison Square Sportsman's Club asking them to switch home clubs to Madison Square. With a growing team Madison offers more fields and more club availability because they have no other events. This year Ram Nitro has 43 Shooters and expecting 60 shooters for 2023. Advantage to Madison is all kids can practice together and extra fields shorten practice time.

To try and maintain Ram Nitro Team at Rockford Sportsman's Club, RSC has offered additional days to conduct practice and open availability by appointment for coaches to use facilities for coaching.

**Guest Terry Bowen** - 2021 budget \$820, looking to repeat for 2022. Shooting volume is down, believes it's a direct correlation to ammunition shortages. Defensive Pistol will need targets, Terry will order in smaller volume so we don't need to store the targets or risk loss or damage.

Defensive Pistol Roof is leaking and needs repair. Sheet metal roofing at Menards is between \$500 and \$600, Home Depot cost was \$900. Terry will get a quote from Miller Steel and return to the June board meeting to make a board decision on how to repair roof.

**Steve Mitchell** – Keypad gate is operational as of 5/9. Follow instructions on gate. Do not adjust photo safety eye. Back up equipment is in Shoot building file cabinet with paperwork on gate. Project came in under budget and \$2000 under retail estimates.

- Steve, Bill Skallos and Dan Vincent met with engineer for final club HVAC update on May 5<sup>th</sup>. Current equipment is underrated for cooling, No fresh air intake, Poor air quality. Duct work needs to be expanded.

Two Design proposals,

Design 1-preferred method, 17.5 Ton AC, Consumers does not have power requirements for this on Northland Dr. Unit would be located between club house and shoot building

Design 2- 3 packaged 5 ton staged units in series. Economizer mixes ambient air to get make-up air.

Tim DeGeest and Ryan Cordes will look to get Bids from Local HVAC contractors.

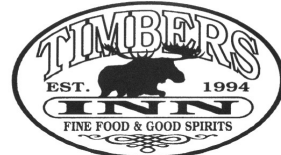
