- Insurance check has arrived for the lightning damage that occurred to the club.
- Discussion about the state of the SCTP financial statements & where the money is being spent.
- Discussed what the status was of them taking over their own finances and getting them off of our books.
- Also had discussion as to the tax-exempt status of the club. As far as we know, we are exempt from paying sales tax.

Sergeant of Arms: Dan Vincent

- Discussed the process of the insurance claim & how we will be reimbursed for the damaged items.
- Still figuring out how much metal siding we will need for the skeet houses. Looks like the cost will be a bit under what we had budgeted.
- Discussed the replacement of the siding on the shoot building & looking to install vinyl in place of the wood that is currently there.
- Working on the low house skeet machine replacement, but it has been slow going. Once we get the tractor back, we will replace the high house.
- Once we get the old machines removed, we will send them to Tyler trap to be re-built.
- Target prices went up significantly so we will be raising the shooting fees as of 9/1. New rate is \$5/line.
- New Shoot Card prices will be:
 - \$125 for non-members
 - \$105 for adult members
 - \$95 for junior members
